- This file contains all full time state employees who were paid in 2008. Please note that the employee could have left at some time during the year or could have started at a time other than January 1. So, the dollars reflected are the actual dollars paid to that individual.
- There are many types of payments that would be included in the other earnings field. Listed below are a few examples:
  - o Uniform allowances
  - o Overtime
  - o Sick & Annual Leave payments
  - o Criminal Justice Incentive Pay
  - State Active Duty pay
  - Military Supplement pay For those employees currently involved in a military deployment
